## Question of the Week—February 5, 2012

5th Sunday in Ordinary Time - Gospel: Mark 1: 29-39

There are days we may feel just like Job in the first reading when he states: “Is not man’s life on earth a drudgery?” We all have days in which we need relief from the troubles in our lives, whether those include serious illness, or the aches and pains of getting older, or the emotional hurt others can inflict on us. We all have times we look for relief. In the Gospel we see Jesus healing people: Simon’s mother-in-law and many others who were brought to him with diseases of body and mind. This constant demand had to take a toll on Jesus’ own energy. So what did he do? *“Rising very early before dawn, he left and went to a deserted place where he prayed.”* If Jesus Christ, the Messiah and Son of God, stopped to pray before going on with the work he was given to do, what kind of example does that give each of us?

**Question:** What benefits have I experienced when I have taken the time to pray? What do I think Jesus prayed for?

## Your Stewardship Matters

*“Rising very early before dawn, he left and went off to a deserted place, where he prayed...He told them, ‘Let us go on to the nearby villages that I may preach there also. For this purpose have I come.’” (Mark 1:35, 38)*

Through today’s Gospel reading we see a perfect example of stewardship. Jesus gives His time doing all that God wishes—healing the sick and preaching. Yet, Jesus also makes time to be alone in prayer. It is only through prayer, through spending time with God, that any of us can find the strength to do all that God wishes us to do. Be sure to find time this week to be with God.

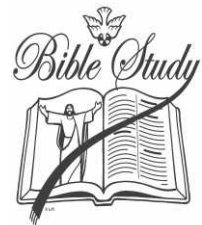
