

SMPAA Board Meeting Minutes

Meeting commenced at 7:09 p.m.

- 1) Soccer Clinic: 2 Wave players, 1 professional goalie, 1 Thomas More Coach and 1 Wave Coach will run the soccer clinic over Spring Break. Kids ages 2nd – 8th grades are invited to attend Tuesday – Friday from 9:00 a.m. – Noon. On Friday after lunch K4-1st Graders are invited. There will be a camp cookout for lunch on Friday and parents are invited as well. Volunteers are needed. John Otto is coordinating the event.
- 2) A Volleyball clinic will be held once a week and will last for 4 weeks in April. Grades 4th – 7th are invited to attend. SMPAA agreed to put up the money to reserve the East Middle School gym for the event with Andy motioning to give \$90 and Jamie seconding. Stacey Sims is coordinating the event. Brian made mention to set a standard or rule around clinics and the amount SMPAA will contribute in the future.
- 3) Soccer coordinators meeting yielded news that at Divine Mercy, no one stepped up to replace the guys in charge of the BVPSL soccer program. - 5) BVPSL will look to sell goals at Cousins Center. Rick Cheaney is talking to Thomas More as they currently use them to see if they want to buy them.
- 6) Treasurer Report: Rick Cheaney delivered report. SpiritWear made \$75. Gym rental fees are starting to come in to be paid by SMPAA. Coaches Clinics are welcome by any sport. Motion to approve report by Brian, seconded by John, passed.
- 7) SMPAA agreed to buy woodchips for the playground. The cost would be around \$2000.
- 8) New business: Andy, none. Tom, none. John, none. Jamie, none. Brian, none. Marty mentioned making sure volunteers are staffed properly for Soccer Classic. John said that he spoke with Volleyball Coordinator, and since the money raised at the Soccer Classic will go to provide uniforms for volleyball, volleyball teams will be asked to volunteer.
